

## Short Biography of Prof. Zefeng Ren

**ZefengRen** was born in 1981 in a beautiful water city, Wuxi, located near Shanghai. He obtained his B.S. degree in chemical physics from the University of Science and Technology of China in 2004 and his Ph. D in physical chemistry under the supervision of Prof. Xueming Yang in Dalian Institute of Chemical Physics (DICP), Chinese Academy of Sciences in 2009. Supported by the Humboldt Foundation, he worked as a postdoc with Prof. Martin Wolf in Fritz Haber Institute of Max Planck Society in Berlin for 2 years. In 2011, he became an assistant professor in Peking University. Since 2016, he moved back to DICP as a full professor and the vice director of the State Key Laboratory of Molecular Reaction Dynamics. His primary research interests are nonlinear spectroscopy at interfaces, ultrafast dynamics of energy materials and the development of new techniques for studying ultrafast dynamics.
